



## **GSC Frostbite Regatta 2023**

### **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, and this Notice of Race. <https://www.sailing.org/raceofficials/eventorganizers/nor.php>
- 1.2 The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

#### **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to sailors who hold valid membership of a Sail Canada affiliated club. Temporary membership will be available to non-members.
- 3.2 Payment and registration online in advance may be made via the GSC website, [www.glenmoresailingclub.com](http://www.glenmoresailingclub.com).
- 3.3 Payment and registration on Saturday, Sept. 9 may be made by cash or cheque payable to "Glenmore Sailing Club".

#### **4 CLASSIFICATION**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all classes of boats up to 7.9 meters (26 feet) in length.
- 4.2 Three or more boats of the same class, registered by 09:00 Saturday, Sept. 9, will constitute a class. All others will sail in either a Handicap Keelboat class or a Handicap Dinghy class.

#### **5 FEES**

- 5.1 Required fees (GST included) are as follows:  
Single Handed \$45  
Double Handed \$60  
Keelboat \$75

## **6 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES**

There will be no qualifying series.

## **8 MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat shall comply with its class rules.

## **9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available at the registration desk on Saturday, September 9.

## **10 VENUE**

10.1 The regatta will be held at the Glenmore Sailing Club in South Glenmore Park on the Glenmore Reservoir in Calgary, Alberta, Canada.

## **11 COURSES**

11.1 There are eight fixed marks numbered 1 through 8 in a clockwise direction around the reservoir. Each of the marks is an orange spar.

11.2 The courses to be sailed for each race shall be indicated by numeral cards displayed on the transom of the Race Committee Barge prior to the preparatory signal of each starting sequence.

11.3 These numeral cards will display the order and side on which the mark is to be left. Numeral cards with a red background indicate a mark left to Port and numeral cards with a green background indicate that a mark is to be left to Starboard.

11.4 A diagram with mark locations will be posted on the Official Notice Board in the GSC clubhouse.

11.5 Optimist sailboats will be notified at the Skipper's meeting if they will use different marks for racing.

## **12 PENALTY SYSTEM**

12.1 For keelboat classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

### **13 SCORING**

13.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

13.3 Number of races will be at the discretion of the Race Officer. The target is to run 5 races in one day.

### **14 SUPPORT BOATS**

No support boats will be allowed on the reservoir.

### **15 BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept ashore in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

### **16 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

16.1 All boats shall be hauled out at the end of each day before sunset.

16.2 Launches are at South Glenmore Park and at Heritage Park on the east arm.

### **17 WATERCRAFT EQUIPMENT**

17.1 Swimming, surfing, inflatable and motorized craft are not allowed on the Glenmore Reservoir.

17.2 Outboard motors shall not be used.

### **18 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

### **19 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in all classes. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

3 boats: 1st Place

4-5 boats: 1st & 2nd Place

6 or more boats: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place

### **20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### **21 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

### **22 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

By participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants the organizing authority and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use or show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.
